

APPLICATION

- Ensure all surfaces are free from grease, dust and other contaminants to aid with the adhesion process of application.
- Remove outer packaging from roll.
- Place roll in the direction it is to be applied, and unwind 12 inches (300mm) of material. Ensure that this section has adhered to the surface
- Simply roll along the surface using hands, ensuring that it rolls in a straight line.
- · Smooth out with hands as it unwinds.

LIMITATIONS

- Shield Hard Surface Protector is not for use on carpeted surfaces.
- For improved adhesion ensure surface is dry and dust free.
- Always check that the film has stuck firmly prior to commencing work.
- To check for compatibility, a test area is always recommended prior to full
- In warm, humid environments or in areas of high traffic, remove Shield Hard Surface Protector after 1 week maximum.
- Do not use on surfaces which have a likelihood to bleed oils and plasticizers.
- Mop up any spillages as product may become slippery when wet, and replace film where necessary.
- Remove Shield Hard Surface Protector after a maximum of 30 days, to prevent a sticky residue being left on the surface.
- If in doubt when determining whether Shield Hard Surface Protector is suitable for use, contact TIMco technical support for further advice.
